

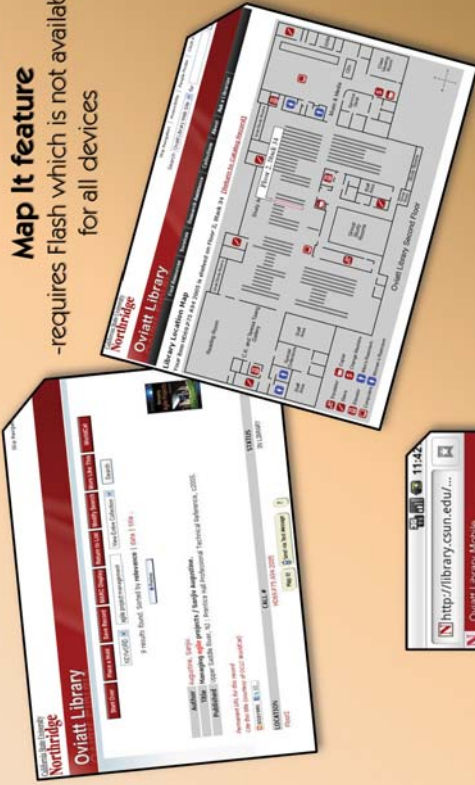

Using Agile Project Management for Mobile Library Services

The Oviatt Library has a new Mobile Strategy Planning and Project Group whose purpose is to provide a forum and framework for planning and coordinating the Library's services for mobile users using agile project management. This management style uses teams that follow the five-phase model:

Envision-Speculate-Explore-Adapt-Close

Traditional management models are task-oriented and follow the six-phase model: Initiate-Plan-Define-Design-Build-Test. Composition of the agile project teams may include faculty, staff, and/or student library employees in an attempt to harness the collective knowledge of those who assist library users. Our users are students, faculty, staff and the public. We have undergraduate and graduate level programs in health administration, health education, nursing, physical therapy, kinesiology, communication disorders, radiology, environmental health, biology, and chemistry.

- Review mobile service development priorities
- Develop a series of small, iterative projects
- Prioritize the projects
- Review and reprioritize after each project cycle
