LGBTQ Cultural Competency for Healthcare

California recently passed the Gender Recognition Act, which adds a "nonbinary" gender option on state documents.

- Starting in September 2018, people are able to submit applications for a new gender on their birth certificates to "nonbinary"
- Starting Jan 2, 2019, people are able to choose a gender category of "male, female, or nonbinary" on CA driver's licenses
- New options for driver's license: F, M, or X
- Court-ordered gender changes in California will move to a self-attested standard; no physician declaration needed
- Keck needs to ensure we have systems in place that respect and welcome nonbinary people
